MISSIONARY Spotlight


Tony & Carrie Given, Missionaries with The Mission Society (TMS) Global

Dear Friends at Baldwinsville Community Wesleyan Church,

Thank you so much for your continued and unwavering partnership with our family over the last 8 years. Your support means so very much to our family! We are delighted to share what God is doing in and through us lately.

1) We continue to work closely with "our Indian children" and our ministry partners in northeast India. Over the last year, we have partnered more significantly with another NGO from the States called

Love Justice International to help our 5 young adults in India as well as 3 young adults in Nepal to have the opportunity to study at the only North American style Christian University in Europe, LCC International University in Lithuania. Just last week, I, Carrie accompanied the 3 Nepali students to LCC to help them get settled. I will be making at least one more trip and possibly 2 more trips to Lithuania before the close of 2021 to accompany "our Indian children" to LCC's campus. Please pray for every detail of their applications, admissions, visas, police



2) We are working with the mobilization department at TMS GLOBAL to create a curriculum called

"Who is My Neighbor?" to help equip and mobilize the Church for the mission of God. This project is already 2 years in the making. We hope to have it finalized and ready to be published by the end of 2022.

3) In August, we began a 2-year mentorship with Laura, a young lady from Indiana who wants to serve in India. She moved to the Columbus area to live cross-culturally and to prepare for life and ministry in India. It has been an honor to walk alongside her.

AFTER SCHOOL-GOOD NEWS CLUB AT CWC REPORT:

We are having a wonderful time in our Good News Club! We have 9 regular staff plus 2 parents have come to help. They have been working one-on-one with our 9 students in our Small Group Time. The children have been reviewing their Bible verses learned last year. I am SO thrilled how well they have remembered them! They are learning new Bible verses, completing chapters in their devotional book, "Every Day with God" Book 2 and memorizing songs. Each accomplishment earns prizes now and some at the end of the year. So far 4 children (Kate, Austin, Julian and Sam) have become 5'ers in our yearly contest. Alyvia is a 15'er! Ayla has completed her first devotional book!

Large Group: In learning about the prophet Elijah, (using flashcards, props, and roleplay,) we are seeing how powerful and caring our mighty God is. We reviewed the Gospel, which is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes. (Romans 1:16) Using visual aids and questions, the students were able to tell me each part of the Gospel. Our prayer is that each student will receive God's salvation, experience a close walk with Him, and share the Gospel with others. We will continue our lessons on Elijah: Prophet of the Living God then begin our Christmas lessons.

You can also pack your own box at home. Grab a pre-printed shoebox in the church foyer. You can donate the cost of shipping online and use the special pre-printed adhesive label that will allow you track your shoebox. Then in a few months you will receive an email letting you know the destination of your shoebox gift. 
CWKIDZ:


